General John A. 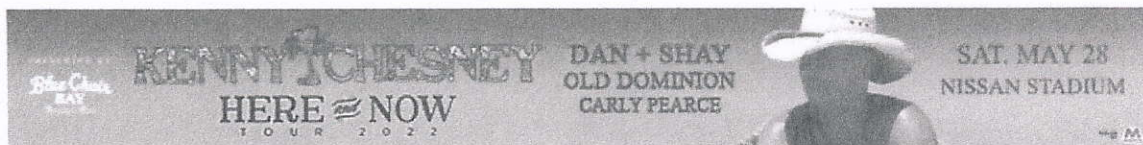


The annual Williamson County Memorial Day ceremony will be held Monday at 10 a.m. in Veterans Park in downtown Franklin.

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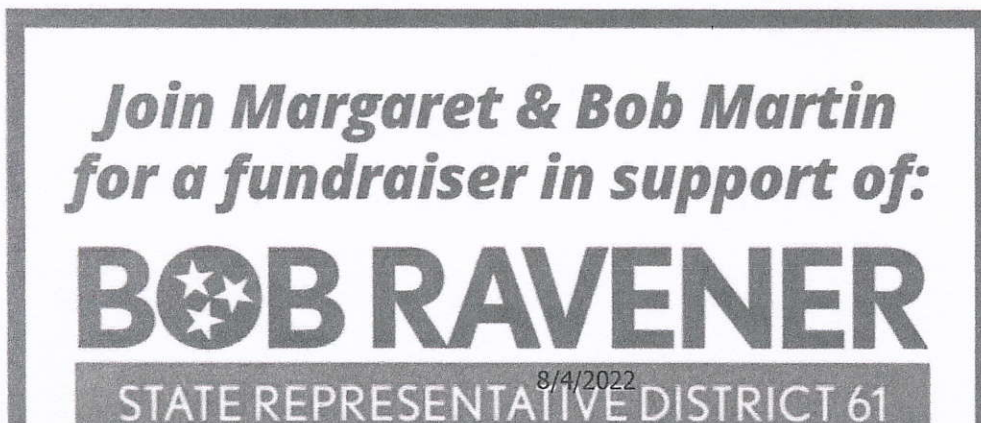

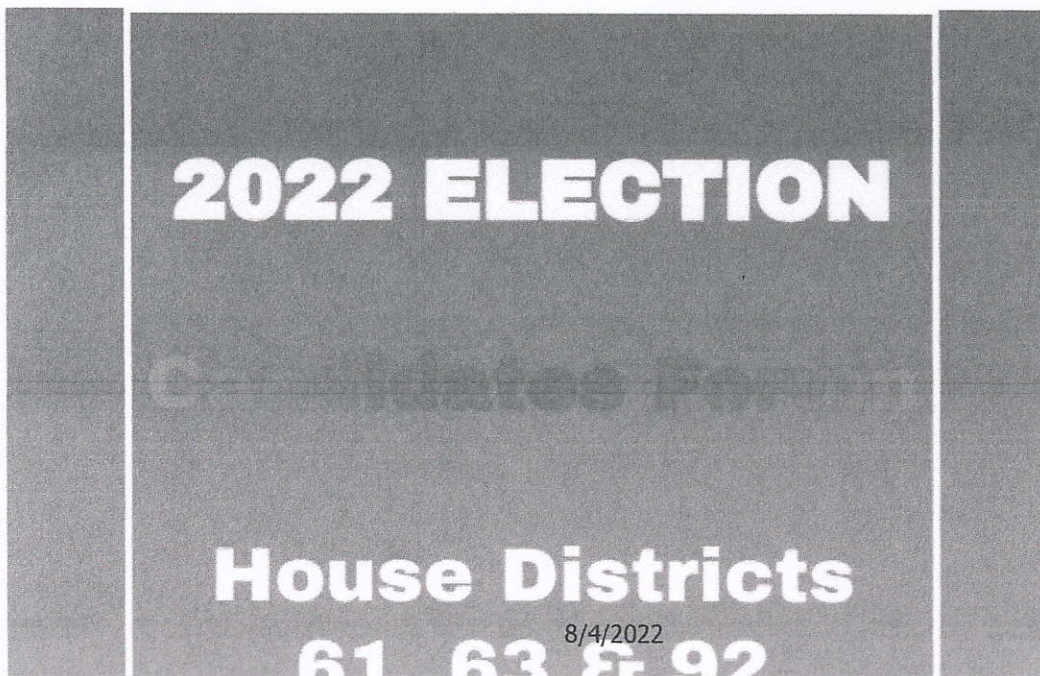

Today, a group of citizens held a rally for which we had a public gathering permit (see attached) issued by the City of Franklin. This rally was on the sidewalk in front of the Monticello neighborhood down to the Mack Hatcher intersection. At the beginning of the event, the owner of Brownland Farm, Robin Anderton, drove his non-street legal utility terrain vehicle across Hillsboro Road onto Monticello Rd. and told everyone who was parked along the edge of Monticello Rd. that they were parked illegally on private property (which Robin Anderton does not own), and that he was going to call the police and get our cars towed.

Then Kevin Estes of Land Solutions arrived and drove his truck through the Eatherly property, got out of his truck and started tearing down yard signs that had been placed as part of the rally. Shortly thereafter Robin Anderton drove his UTV back out onto Hillsboro Rd., past the rally and onto the sidewalk. He got out and began to tear down signs placed along the sidewalk and got back into his vehicle and left. I have attached a link to a video of that incident involving Mr. Anderton. Both Mr. Estes and Mr. Anderton interfered with our right to peaceful assembly. Prior to the end of the rally signs belonging to citizens were stolen and taken onto Brownland Farm by an individual in a white pickup truck.
